Music Competition

Music Competitions 11am-2pm, \$10/comp. Only traditional Irish music will be accepted. Music classifications: reel, jig (double, slip & single jig), hornpipe air, march & polka. Electronic or amplified instruments will not be permitted. A tin whistle must have a metal body, a plastic tip and only six holes. A beginner is anyone who started playing a particular instrument after January 1, 2014. Beginners will play only one piece from one of the classifications below. Advanced will play two pieces of contrasting tempo, one from any two classifications below. Duets must have two different instruments & play two pieces of contrasting tempo. Entrants may compete in only one category for each instrument. Entry will be accepted on day of feis. U12 competitions start at 11:00am. 12&O competitions start at noon. If you have a time conflict with your dance competition you may play anytime between 11:00am – 2:00pm. All competitions will be kept open until 2:00pm
