

Directions to Irish Cultural Centre, 200 New Boston Drive, Canton, MA

From the North: Take Rt 93 South to Exit 2A towards Stoughton, Rt 138 South. After about 4 miles, turn right onto New Boston Dr.

From the West: Take Route 90 East to Exit 14 for Route 95 South/128 S towards South Shore/Cape Cod. Merge onto 93 North/US-1 N via exit 12 on the left toward Boston. Merge onto MA-138 S via EXIT 2A toward Stoughton. After about 4 miles, turn right onto New Boston Dr.

From the South: Take onto MA-24 N toward Boston. Take EXIT 19B toward Central St. Merge onto Harrison Blvd, which becomes Central St. Turn right onto Washington St/MA-138. Continue to follow MA-138. Turn left onto New Boston Dr.

From the East: Take Rt 3 North toward Quincy/Boston. Merge onto I-93 S/US-1 S via EXIT 20A on the left toward I-95/Canton. Merge onto MA-138 S via EXIT 2A toward Stoughton. Turn right onto New Boston Dr.

SPECIAL COMPETITIONS

Music Competitions 10am-2pm, \$10/comp. Only traditional music will be accepted. Music classifications: reels, jigs (double, slip & single jig), hornpipe aires, marches & polkas. Electronic or amplified instruments will not be permitted. A tin whistle must have a metal body, a plastic tip and only six holes. A beginner is anyone who started playing a particular instrument after January 1, 2013. Beginners will play only one piece from one of the classifications below. Duets must have two different instruments & play two pieces of contrasting tempo. Trios must have at least two different instruments & play two pieces of contrasting tempo. Entrants may compete in only one category for each instrument. entry will be accepted on day of feis.
